Comments : HABER 20 mini Reporter:

- new member of the fascinating HABER family - After carefully studying our success with the motor yacht, HABER 33 Reporter, and the market demand for motorboats, we decided to create a new boat, smaller and more universal , which we named - HABER 20 mini Reporter. -

- As its name suggests, this yacht offers similar comfort, quality and performance to its big brother HABER 33 Reporter and its use is just as versatile. - - It is ideal for private use as well as charter companies.

- Thanks to its low draft, which in the keelless version is only 20 cm, there is practically no place on cruising waters, canals or maritime coastal waters that would not be accessible for the HABER 20 mini Reporter. Magnificent places, until now inaccessible, are to be explored. A long, shallow keel can be used to provide heading stability, with a draft of 0.35 m or side fins operating from the cockpit, giving a draft of 0.65 m.

HABER 20 mini Reporter has an air draft of 1.5m (and 2.17m in the version with a high superstructure which protects the helmsman's position and the cockpit from wind and rain)

- this means that the boat can pass under all bridges on the waterways.

Considering the comfort and spacious interior, the yacht should actually be named "maxi" Reporter - five people can sleep comfortably, or two people can, very comfortably, spend a few weeks' vacation on board this luxurious boat.

There is a large bed in the forepeak, where three people could sleep comfortably.
