Titango of the site Alexandre Genoud boats, maintained by nautical site (wood/epoxy construction, shell paint 2020, bridge varnish and the panel 2020, new HB engine). 2022 dormant mast and winter. Winter under hangar 7 months a year.

Low-weighted dinghy with a free franc (0.30m/1.40m), it offers large sensations to its crew.

Teak bridge, mahogany table, Oregon pine pie, Titango Marie Different wooden essence to better seduce you.

The narrow cockpit is supervised by a slight hiloire, and the largely listening cart is rejected on the rear deck with the listening that returns to a central turret.

The interior in mahogany slats is superb.

The hydraulic command on stainless steel line of lifting the keel is very accessible.

Installation of the speedboat is a model of the genre for a small unit (well under the bar).

This Day-Boat has a suspended saffron that rises horizontally and a swivel lead keel (220 kg) which allow it to fail or be transported on a trailer.
