This model is renowned for its good sailing performance, thanks to a well-designed hull and adequate balancing. It performs well under sail while offering pleasant navigation.

Equipped with a set of high quality and recent sails (2020), all the standing rigging was changed in 2020. The design of the sailboat allows good maneuverability, even solo or with a small crew.

The construction is robust and high quality, which ensures good durability and increased safety at sea. All valves and hull fittings changed in 2020.

Its powerful YANMAR 85 HP engine ensures greater safety and is capable of withstanding the varied conditions encountered at sea. Mounted on a shaft, with barely 2000 hours, a diesel capacity of 200l, it has benefited from a complete overhaul by a professional in 2020.

With large capacity tanks for water and fuel, as well as good storage capacity, this Oceanis 461 Clipper allows you to go on extended cruises without having to worry too often about refueling. It also has 2 solar panels on a portico.
