This Dufour 425 Grand Large from the DUFOUR shipyard is a 12.90 meter monohull sailboat designed to offer an excellent combination of comfort, performance and safety at sea. This model, popular with sailing enthusiasts, is distinguished by its robustness, its elegant design and functional layout, ideal for cruises with family or friends.
