Owner's Comments

Its owner tells us:

Designed by the Duo Andrieu and Verdier, and built in full in infusion, the Sun Fast 3300 benefits from exceptional resistance and rigidity, with a considerably reduced weight. Therefore, it offers not only excellent absolute performance, but it also benefits from an advantage with regard to the disability rules of the IRC, in particular thanks to its simple keel without bulb and its reasonable canvas surface.

On this racing sailboat, ergonomics are at the service of efficiency: spacious cockpit to facilitate travel, adjustment systems brought back to the barriers for solo crossings. 5% faster than the 3200 version, the Sun Fast 3300 is still as stable and balanced on technical routes. His shell was specially drawn with the aim of increasing his performance on the gait of bearing.

This 2020 jauged 0.30 model won the UNCL 2022 Atlantic Championship in crew and had to declare for the transquadra for health reasons of its skipper/owner. Its specific inventory guarantees it higher performance than other Sun Fast 3300 in its category (special preparation of the front launching hull, lighter ilx veil than carbon sail, 3 x symmetrical spinnies for better speed in the bearer, 5 60 m2 code on emmagasineur, 3 -speed winchs karver, combined GPS GARMIN GARME GPSMAP 8416 Integrated WiFi and NMEA 183/2000, with solar panel for permanent load ...).
